This term we are learning...

Our Year 1 topic this term is 'Outdoor Explorers'. In science lessons we will learn about the structures of common plants and trees. In geography lessons we will learn about the differences between two areas of the world. In art, craft and design lessons we will construct a bird in 3d.

Phonics

In phonics the children will carry on working in their phonics groups. They will continue to learn the different sounds letters make and use these to read words. Children will also read books linked to their phonics ability and answer questions about what they have read.

English

In English we will be focusing the story of 'Jack & the Jelly Bean Stalk.' We will be re-writing sections of the story using ambitious vocabulary and then write our own versions of the story. We will be focusing on using capital letters, full stops, adjectives and conjunctions.

Maths

During this half term the children will work on counting in steps of 2's, 5's and 10's and will begin to learn about multiplication and division. Children will also learn about fractions of shapes and amounts.
